

24/7 EMERGENCIES



Immediate emergency management:

- Medical and surgical emergencies
- 24/7 access to medical and technical facilities
- Trauma resuscitation rooms for patients requiring heavy care

TRAUMA CENTER EMERGENCY CLUSTER



The Mohammed VI International University Hospital is equipped with a level 2 Trauma-Center according to the European classification. It houses:

- An emergency, trauma and orthopedic, anesthesia and extensive resuscitation (adult and pediatric) department
- All surgical specialties (neurosurgery, visceral surgery, etc.)
- Interventional radiology
- Means of mass transfusion
- Follow-up and Rehabilitation Care (FRC).

The Trauma Center has:

- 2 trauma resuscitation rooms
- 10 intensive care beds for short-term hospitalization
- 49 hospital beds

HEAD AND NECK CLUSTER

The Mohammed VI International University Hospital's Head and Neck Cluster of is oriented towards traumatic pathologies, in synergy with the Cheikh Khalifa International University Hospital. Among the different specialties related to this cluster:

Neurosurgery focuses on trauma injuries, including brain injuries, spinal injuries and peripheral nerve injuries.

ENT and maxillofacial surgery aims to develop techniques related to traumatic pathology. Thus, reconstructive surgery concerns both aesthetic and functional aspects. The techniques of treatment of deafness (cochlear implant) will be maintained initially at the Cheikh Khalifa International University Hospital.

Ophthalmology focuses on traumatic pathologies of the eye, especially those related to the posterior segment and retinal pathology.

In general, this cluster benefits from a complete integration of the various specialties available in the Trauma Center (anesthesia, blood bank, resuscitation) and a state-of-the-art technical platform (imaging, operating theatre) to meet its needs.



WOMAN - MOTHER - CHILD - NEWBORN - MAR CLUSTER

The Mohammed VI International University Hospital is equipped with a Woman - Mother - Child - Newborn - MAR cluster, which houses medical specialties from pregnancy to childbirth as well as neonatal and pediatric specialties and resuscitation.



Gynecology - Obstetrics:

The gynecology-obstetrics department offers care for pregnant women: pregnancy follow-up, obstetrical ultrasound, hospitalization of pathological pregnancies, preparation for birth and breastfeeding, postnatal consultations and perineal rehabilitation.

It also deals with cancerous diseases such as breast cancer with oncoplastic surgery and sentinel lymph node, surgery for cervical and uterine cancer, ovarian cancer, and endometrial cancer.

Surgery is also provided for benign diseases such as uterine fibroids, uterine prolapse, urinary incontinence, and other female diseases.

The gynecology-obstetrics department has a consultation unit, a delivery room with 6 large and modern single rooms, an operating theatre, and a 21-bed hospitalization unit.

All of these units work closely with the neonatology, radiology, pediatrics, biology, and resuscitation units.

MAR - Medically-Assisted Reproduction

The Reproductive Medicine Department treats infertility pathologies and assists families with medically assisted reproduction projects.

- Al (Artificial Insemination): with the spouse's sperm
- IVFET (In Vitro Fertilization and Embryo Transfer)
- ICSI (Intracytoplasmic Sperm Injection)
- IMSI (Intracytoplasmic Morphologically Selected Sperm Injection)
- Freezing of embryos
- Techniques added to IVF or ICSI: extended culture, assisted hatching.

OUTPATIENT CHEMOTHERAPY

Personalized care, applying the most recent protocols in cancerology. Treatment of cancerous pathologies that do not require hospitalization.

Security:

- Reconstitution of cytotoxic products by specialized professionals, allowing nurses to focus on patient care
- Control of prescriptions by the pharmacy of the Mohammed VI International University Hospital

ENDOSCOPY



Digestive endoscopy

The gastroenterology department of the Mohammed VI International University Hospital welcomes patients with digestive pathology. The gastroenterologists' functioning within groups enables most of the aspects of gastroenterology to be taken care of, with:

- Daily consultations and a 24/7 on-call service for patients followed or hospitalized in the establishment
- Endoscopic activity: gastroscopies, colonoscopies and video-capsules
- Realization of digestive ultrasound
- Interventional endoscopy activity including: biliary tract procedures, stone extractions and biliary prosthesis with or without prior echo-endoscopy, digestive, esophageal, duodenal, biliary or colonic stenting (prosthesis).

A new generation sterile cluster

The Mohammed VI International University Hospital is ahead of the standards and obligations of the international recommendations of learned societies by opening a sterile cluster for washing, drying, and storing heat-sensitive endoscopes. It offers several advantages:

- It contributes to the reliability of the traceability of care thanks to the storage of heat-sensitive endoscopies in enclosures that guarantee decontamination for 72 hours
- It helps to improve the working conditions of the caregivers (easy maintenance)
- It respects the environment because it saves a maximum of 2 washes per tube.

ENDOSCOPY

Technical platform

Thanks to its high-performance technical platform, the Mohammed VI International University Hospital provides care for a large number of aspects of gastroenterology, from diagnosis to treatment of diseases of the digestive tract (esophagus, stomach, small intestine, and colon), liver, bile ducts, and pancreas.

By equipping its two endoscopy rooms with the latest generation of equipment, the hospital is improving the quality and safety of care for both patients and caregivers:

- An improved patient care pathway (wards located close to the department), thus allowing care from diagnosis onwards, including in emergencies
- Perfect control of the endoscopic process
- Greater availability of the equipment (24/7) thanks to the storage cabinets allowing the nursing staff to develop their field of intervention by optimizing their schedule.



ANAESTHESIA - RESUSCITATION



Anesthesia and perioperative care:



- Pre-anesthetic consultations
- Anesthesia in the operating theatre, in delivery rooms and in technical platforms
- Endoscopy, interventional radiology and Medically-Assisted Reproduction



- General pathologies with dermatological expression (lupus, vascularity...)

ENDOCRINOLOGY - DIABETOLOGY





Endocrinology:

- Thyroid pathologies (nodules, goiter, hypothyroidism and hyperthyroidism)
- Pathologies of puberty and growth
- Adrenal pathologies (hyperpilosity, Addison's disease, Cushing's syndrome, ...)
- Pituitary pathologies (pituitary adenoma, corticotropic insufficiency after corticosteroid therapy, diabetes insipidus....)
- Metabolic pathologies (hypercholesterolemia, hypertriglyceridemia, hypertension, overweight...).

OBSTETRICS AND GYNECOLOGICAL SURGERY



Gynecological surgery

- Surgery under hysteroscopy: uterine fibroids, uterine polyps, uterine synechiae, endometrectomy, tubal sterilization
- Hysteroscopic or laparoscopic fibroid surgery
- Cervical surgery (laser conization)
- Total or subtotal hysterectomy with or without ovarian conservation, by hysteroscopy or laparoscopy
- Ovarian surgery: removal of cysts and tumors
- Fertility surgery: tuboplasty, destruction of endometriosis, removal of adhesions...
- Surgery for pelvic endometriosis
- Surgery for urinary stress incontinence
- Surgery of pelvic static disorders by laparoscopic, natural or mixed approach: genital, bladder or rectal prolapse.

Hématology:

Among the hemopathies, there are cancers, which are called hematological cancers :

- Lymphoma
- Leukemias
- Myeloma
- Other blood diseases...

Oncology:

 Tumors (brain, ENT, endocrine, lung, gynecological, prostate, digestive tract...)

INTERNAL MEDICINE





Internal medicine is a versatile specialty that deals with the internal organs (such as the heart, lungs, digestive system, etc.).

- Diagnosis and comprehensive management of adult diseases
- Systemic diseases
- Autoimmune diseases
- Complex and rare cases.

PHYSICAL MEDICINE AND REHABILITATION



Physical and rehabilitation medicine takes care of people with a disability or physical incapacity (as a result of an illness or accident), in order to minimize the consequences of this deficit on their daily life.

The therapeutic field of physical medicine and rehabilitation is very broad:

- Multiple sclerosis
- Parkinson's disease
- Cerebrovascular accident (CVA)
- Paralysis
- Amputation
- Neuromuscular diseases
- Chronic pain
- Heart failure
- Delays in walking
- Language disorders...

Physical and rehabilitation medicine also takes care of the aftermath of an accident, a joint prosthesis or an apparatus, or even sportsmen and women who have suffered injuries.

NEUROLOGY



Diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the brain, spinal cord, peripheral nerves and muscles.

- Vascular diseases: strokes, transient ischemic attacks (TIAs)
- Degenerative diseases (Alzheimer's, Parkinson's...)
- Central nervous system pathologies: epilepsy (clinical assessment; electroencephalogram); multiple sclerosis and vasculitis; brain tumors
- Pathologies of the peripheral nervous system (polyneuritis, sciatica) and muscle diseases
- Migraines and headaches.

NEPHROLOGY - NEPHROPEDIATRICS



Nephrology

- Acute or chronic renal failure
- Renal colic
- Proteinuria (presence of protein in the urine)
- Hematuria (blood in the urine).
- Nephritic syndrome
- Glomerulonephritis
- Recurrent urinary tract infections.

Pediatric nephrology

- Acute or chronic kidney disease
- Nephrotic syndromes (proteinuria)
- Developmental abnormalities of the kidneys or urinary tract (small
- kidneys, uropathy)
- Genetic kidney diseases
- Renal pathologies of infectious or immunological origin (lupus)
- Kidney stones and other causes of hematuria
- Metabolic diseases with renal involvement
- Renal failure (acute or chronic), regardless of cause
- High blood pressure.

OPHTHALMOLOGY AND OPHTHALMIC SURGERY



Diagnosis and treatment of all eye diseases

Anterior segment of the eye:

- Refractive disorders (myopia, hyperopia, astigmatism, presbyopia)

Posterior segment of the eye:

- Retinal diseases (including age-related macular degeneration or AMD)
- Vitreous diseases

- Eyelid and tear duct disorders.

The Mohammed VI International University Hospital check-up service is a center dedicated to preventive medicine and screening, allowing early treatment and better management of any unidentified, silent or even unknown pathologies.

General check-up:

- Cardio vascular check-up

- Dietetic assessment to advise and supervise the quality of your food according to your needs.

Smoking check-up:

- Complete respiratory exploration

For patients asking for, there is also a Moming check-up that takes place over half a day and whic is a quick and personalized health check-up.

OUTPATIENT HOSPITALIZATION



Outpatient hospitalization (also called "Day Hospital") is a mode of hospitalization allowing the patient to be taken care of during the day and to return home the same day.

Outpatient hospitalization is booming in many disciplines: Vascular, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, General and Digestive Surgery, ENT, Gynecology, Pediatrics.

It is also an alternative to full hospitalization for a large number of diagnostic and/or interventional procedures, performed under anesthesia:

- Endoscopy (gastroscopy, colonoscopy, bronchoscopy)
- Angiography and coronary angiography
- In-vitro fertilization procedures under anesthesia.
- Day hospital surgery: The DH surgery has 27 places including 8 stretcher chairs, 2 individual rooms and 17 beds.
- Chemotherapy day hospital: The chemotherapy day hospital has 25 places including 1 room with 18 chairs and 7 individual boxes.
- Medicine day hospital: The medicine day hospital has 10 seats.

SERVICE HOSPITALISATION

FULL HOSPITALIZATION



Full hospitalization offers a certain comfort to the patient:

- Double, single or suite rooms
- Private bathroom
- Air conditioning
- Phone
- Smart TV
- Wireless internet access (Wi-Fi).

The work organization of the care units favors the availability of the caregivers to the patient.

Trauma-center hospitalization:

The Mohammed VI International University Hospital has 2 Trauma Center units which are divided as follows

- Trauma Center Unit 1:
 - Capacity of 26 beds including 8 orthopedic beds, 2 VIP rooms, 10 single rooms, 2 double rooms and 2 isolation rooms.
- Trauma Center Unit 2: Capacity of 22 beds including 2 VIP rooms, 10 single rooms, 4 double rooms and 2 isolation rooms.



SERVICE HOSPITALISATION

Gynecology and obstetrics hospitalization:

This structure has 20 beds, a nursery and a childcare area.



Medical and surgical hospitalization:

This section has 2 units with a total bedding capacity of 35 beds.

Pediatric hospitalization:

It has a capacity of 39 beds, a playground, and a general playful environment adapted to children patients.



Oncology hospitalization:

It has 29 beds shared between 13 single rooms, 6 double rooms, 2 isolation rooms and 2 VIP suites.

VIP hospitalization:

This section offers high standard accommodation and ancillary services and has $12\ \text{Gold}$ suites.

MEDICAL AND TECHNICAL SERVICES

The medical and technical services of the Mohammed VI International University Hospital are made up of medical and non-medical health professionals and are divided into different units:

- Medical Laboratory Unit
- Medical Radiology Unit.

These units are service providers for both the other clinical clusters and the public.

Each department has a unit manager assisted by practitioners and specialist staff as well as administrative staff.



LABORATORY



The laboratory of the Mohammed VI International University Hospital covers all biological disciplines

- Current biochemistry
- Hematology, hemostasis
- Bacteriology
- Anatomopathology
- Routine and specialized immunology
- Assays for prenatal diagnosis of the Down's Syndrome
- Assays for medically-assisted reproduction

Some tests must be performed on an empty stomach. In case of doubt, contact the laboratory secretariat.

RADIOLOGY



MRI

- Magnetic resonance imaging, using the magnetic properties of the human body, non-irradiating and without risk for the patients
- Reference imaging for the examination of a large number of organs: central nervous system, joints, liver, bile ducts, pancreas, ENT, prostate, women's imaging (breasts and pelvis)
- Oncology: from simple diagnosis to assessing the severity of a tumor.

Scanner

- Lung, musculoskeletal, neurological, urinary system, child scan
- Oncology: Diagnosis of cancers (lung, breast, colon, etc.) and monitoring of treatment effectiveness
- Arthroscan
- Angioscan of the aorta, neck vessels and lower limbs
- Colon scan (virtual colonoscopy)
- Heart and coronary artery scan
- Interventional: infiltration, puncture, drainage under CT scan guidance.

Mammography

Breast Cancer Screening.

RADIOLOGY



- Abdominal, urinary tract, pelvic, breast, musculotendinous, cervical, thyroid, testicular and prostate ultrasound
- Cervico-encephalic ultrasonography Doppler.

Interventional Radiology

Use of imaging equipment to guide treatments deep into the human body without opening the body.

Panoramic dental X-ray system

Global view of the jaw in order to know the exact location of the teeth, to identify various dental anomalies, and to detect dental and tissue lesions.

Treatment of many pathologies without surgery

- Vascular pathologies: Treatment of blocked arteries or veins, aneurysms, deep varicose veins, embolization of arteries in case of external or internal bleeding
- Oncology: chemoembolization by charged microbeads (administration of anticancer drugs directly into the tumor), tumor destruction by radiofrequency, treatment of tumor obstructions by placing drains or prostheses.
- Gynecology: uterine artery embolization in case of hemorrhage after childbirth, treatment of uterine fibroids by embolization.

In addition to surgical procedures

 Drainage of deep thoracic or abdominal collections or abscesses, without the need for further surgery.

Medical records & patient information requests

How can I get a copy of my medical record?

In order to protect the confidentiality of medical data, it is imperative to send us a written request, written by the patient (or signed by him/her) accompanied by a photocopy of his/her identity card. This written request must include the last name, first name, date of birth and the departments in which the patient has stayed as well as the approximate dates of his or her stays at the Mohammed VI International University Hospital. The desired copies will be sent to you personally within fifteen days of receiving your request in due form.

How can I access my medical file or receive my hospital reports?

The hospitalized person (or his or her legal representatives in the case of a minor or a protected adult) has direct access to health information concerning him. Under certain conditions, in the event of death, the person's legal representatives may also have access to certain elements of the patient's medical record.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

Medical records & patient information requests

I have a question about my treatment, whom should I contact?

You decide what care you choose to receive, and as such, you are free at any time to accept or refuse a treatment (except in case of life-threatening emergency). Doctors are qualified to determine the most appropriate treatment for you. They must inform you of this: do not hesitate to ask them or to ask the care team.

I have an administrative question about my admission or the cost of my stay.

The admissions and accommodation expenses office is at your disposal for the administrative management of your hospitalization.

Is there a welcome booklet for my hospital?

A welcome booklet will be given to you on your arrival in your room. It is intended to facilitate your stay in the hospital. You will find all the practical information you need, concerning the steps to be taken, the services at your disposal, your rights, or the rules of living together.

Who can I contact for information and advice on my social situation?

Social workers are present in each of our departments to respond to your requests and accompany you in your care. You can ask for their contact details from the professionals in your care unit.

Where can I find out about my post-hospital care?

Whether you are continuing your care in another health care facility or returning home, you can prepare for further care with the help of our teams.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

Consultations

Why do I have to show my ID card at every consultation?

Your safety is at stake! The presentation of your identity card allows the medical secretary to identify you correctly and to check the accuracy of your personal data in order to avoid any risk of error.

Why are consultations sometimes delayed?

As the medical diagnosis cannot be established at the time of making the appointment, it is difficult to estimate the exact duration of each consultation. The schedule is therefore subject to change throughout the day. This can cause delays and extend your wait. We apologize for this. Our wish is to help you to the best of our ability. If you can't wait, make a new appointment with our medical secretary.

What can I do to alleviate the delay in consultation?

The consultation is a privileged moment between you and the doctor. Get to the point: explain your case in a precise manner so that the doctor can take care of you in the best possible way. Discussing the health problems of relatives cannot be done in the context of your consultation. If necessary, invite the persons concerned to make an appointment.

Where can I drop off the CD or result sheets from my previous tests?

Leave any you may have with the receptionist. He or she can attach them to your patient file. Do not forget to give those CD-ROMs or results sheets to the receptionist before seeing the doctor: this will save you time during the consultation.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

Will I receive a copy of the lab results?

The Mohammed VI International University Hospital will give you a copy of your laboratory results only if the prescribing physician has explicitly requested it on the prescription. Otherwise, no advice or interpretation will be provided directly to patients by the sampling center or laboratory.

These results require an interpretation that only your prescribing physician will be able to provide.

Where to eat?

Visitors have access to a cafeteria with sandwiches, drinks, and snacks.

Where can I find accommodation near Mohammed VI International University Hospital?

Where can I find a pharmacy (dispensary)?

There are several pharmacies in the vicinity of the hospital. They are located only a few meters away. Please note: by law, all medicines administered in hospital must be dispensed by the Hospital's Central Pharmacy.

External retail pharmacies therefore only dispense medicines to be used outside the hospital.

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
